The Journey



Step 1. Getting to know you

Join us for a creative and energetic meeting with your designer to get all of your ideas and inspirations out on the table. No matter how wild, we want to hear it all. We will encourage you to dream big and think boldly.

This important step sets the tone for your project, we will develop the brief, delving further into your likes, dislikes and wish list items.

We will also think about the practical stuff, how the space will be used, by who, when and how, literally 'red penning' the plans as we go and asking lots of questions to flush out the detail (e.g. how many people will the dining table need to seat?).

The aim is to create a tangible and well thought through design brief and vision board representing the overall feel of your home and highlighting what is most important to you.

Alongside this, we will be conducting site surveys and our own research, adding ideas, experience and recommendations into the mix.

Step 2. Space Planning

This phase aims to answer the practical questions and allow you to weigh up your layout options, highlighting opportunities, pros and cons.

Can we fit everything in? Will your bookcase hold enough books? Do we need to add or move any sockets or lighting? Where will the Christmas tree go?

The scope of works and nature of this phase will vary depending on the property and your vision. It could be move in ready, need a few tweaks or more extensive revisions.

If any structural work is required, we will work hand in hand with your chosen architect, sense checking their plans from an interior design perspective, confirming architectural details and hard finishes that will be needed for the planning and tender process.

At this stage we will be getting into more detail on timescales and budgets, agreeing key milestones and building on the aesthetics (usually a joint pinterest board).


Step 3. Room Concepts

With the functionality taken care of, we start looking at the details, selecting décor, flooring, furniture, lighting, window treatments, artwork and accessories.

From your brief, we put together a starting point, and then revise, develop and refine the designs with you to make sure every detail is considered.

In the background, we will also be liaising with crafts and trades, conducting site visits to confirm measurements and creating an implementation plan.

The end result will be a comprehensive scheme for each room, brought to life using a collage of SketchUp visuals and product images, alongside samples of fabrics and finishes. You will also receive an itemised estimate and timeline for the supply and installation.



Step 4. Implementation & Installation

We do the heavy lifting. Jeffreys will take care of ordering, admin, organisation, logistics and deliveries to take your project to completion.

Step 5. Finishing Touches

What will the service cost?

Every client is different, so we offer a flexible service tailored exactly to your needs. Get in touch to arrange an initial chat about your requirements. From there we can put together a proposal outlining our approach, with clear budgets, timescales and fees.

When should I start thinking about interior design?

The sooner the better! From order, standard lead times for furniture can be between 3 weeks for stock items to 14 weeks for made to order pieces (e.g. upholstery). For bigger renovations or new builds, we can work from plan, feeding into the programme to make sure everything is chosen and selected in good time.

Who will I be working with?

You will be appointed a lead designer, with you every step of the way from start to completion, supported by our team including designers, admin, warehouse and installation. Our designers are all equally skilled, experienced and versatile in their styles. We allocate projects based on who we think is the best fit but happy to arrange an intro call at this stage if you would like to meet your potential designer in advance.

Do you do everything in house?

We know what we do best and would recommend appointing a specialist to provide the final design, supply and installation for smart home systems, kitchens, bespoke cabinetry, architectural lighting, swimming pools, spas, cinemas and art consultancy. If required for your project, we will help you appoint the right team, and will attend meetings, providing direction on style, reviewing layouts and selecting finishes to ensure it all works together.

Will I be involved in the design process?

We can't wait to see your Pinterest board! We very much welcome a collaborative approach. Your ideas and input are key to the success of the design. If you like to be hands on, a session at the studio to look through fabric and wallpaper libraries could be a good starting point. See what speaks to you, and we can build the schemes from there. Alternatively, if looking at fabric swatches is your nightmare, we can take the brief and do the legwork, presenting you with our recommendations.

I already have some furniture, will this work in my new home?

We are happy to incorporate existing pieces and artwork into your new schemes, it gives a richness and authenticity to the design. Existing items usually fall into two categories; must have sentimental items to build a scheme around and those that still have life in them. We can take inventory of these at the start and give our best advice on what works for your brief and layout, what can be reused and what might be worth reconsidering.
